On January 28, 2019, the beginning of Catholic Schools Week, the 2019-2020 application for the *African Ancestry Ministry and Native American Heritage Tuition Assistance* will be available. African Ancestry Ministry and Evangelization and Native American Tuition Assistance

Description:

Catholic school students (K-12th grade) of African Ancestry and Native American heritage in the Diocese of Raleigh are eligible to apply for tuition assistance. The assistance awards come from funds granted to the diocese from the Black and Indian Mission Office founded by the Catholic bishops of the United States.

- All applicants **MUST** complete a Catholic school enrollment application *and* a FACTS tuition eligibility application before this application will be considered.
- **Application Deadline: March 11, 2019**
- Decision letters will be mailed to parents no later than May 24, 2019
- Tuition awards are sent from the diocese to the applicant's school.

Application opens on January 28, 2019 and closes on March 11, 2019
