Student Programs

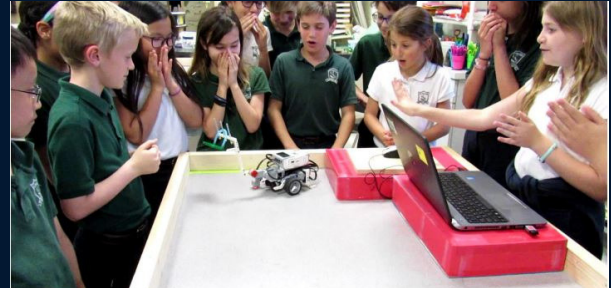
Now that we have the first few days of the new school year under our belts, it's time to share some information about activities your children may want to participate in.
