DAILY UNIFORM

Daily uniforms are traditionally worn Monday-Thursdays.

- White, navy blue or hunter green polo shirts—short or long sleeve with school uniform logo. No performance/"wick-away" fabric.
- Hunter green or navy blue sweatshirts or navy blue SPCS fleece jackets (available from Lands' End) with school uniform logo.
- Navy blue or dark green SPCS spiritwear hoodie - available online at Ink'd Threads.
- Navy or khaki (not light sand color) shorts, trousers, or skorts. Girls shorts should be Bermuda style shorts, no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. Girls skorts should be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. No "jeans style" pants/shorts.

Daily uniforms may be purchased at Lands' End (School Number 900152844), Flynn O'Hara, J.A. Uniforms, Target (Brand: Cat & Jack), Belk (Brands: Izod, Nautica), Old Navy, JCPenney (Brands: French Toast, Izod), Walmart (Brands: George, Wonder Nation).

Polos, sweatshirts and fleeces ordered from Lands' End and Flynn O'Hara will arrive with the school crest already embroidered onto the item. Local monogramming of the school crest is available at Parrott Canvas, Monograms+, and Pirate Threads.

Lands' End offers rain coats, fleece-lined rain coats and puffer jackets with the school logo. If you choose to purchase these, they are for outerwear only, not for in the classroom.

Standard Athletic shoe/tennis shoe, closed at the toe and heel, tied laces or Velcro closure only. No loafer, Mary Jane or clog style shoes/sneakers may be worn.

Boys and girls may wear solid black, white, navy, or grey ankle or crew socks; visible in the shoe, not pulled up to the knee. In addition to those options, girls may wear traditional white or navy knee high socks, solid white or navy tights. Solid white or navy leggings may be worn under girls' skorts and must be covered by the socks at all times so as to appear as tights.

Solid blue, black or brown belt must be worn with pants, shorts, and skorts that have belt loops.

The Wildcat Closet

The school keeps a collection of gently used daily uniform items in the Wildcat Closet in our cafeteria. These are free for the taking, and we encourage parents to donate uniforms they no longer need. Look for times the closet is open during the school year in the Wildcat Weekly or call the front office. The closet will also be open Sunday, July 11 from 6-7 pm and on Monday, July 12 from 12-2 pm.

DRESS UNIFORM

Dress uniforms are worn on Fridays, the day we attend Mass at the church. Students are welcome to wear the dress uniform on Mondays-Thursdays if they so choose. There may be special occasions on which students are asked to wear dress uniforms. Lands' End is the exclusive provider of some of the parts of the Dress Uniform.

Boys

The items required to be purchased from Lands' End are:

- white button-down dress shirt (preferably long-sleeved)
- Saint Peter striped necktie
- OPTIONAL sweater or sweater vest with school logo

The other dress uniform items that can be purchased from any store are:

- khaki pants
- dress shoes, such as bucks, boat shoes or similar dress shoes
- black or brown dress belt
- black or white crew socks

Coats and jackets are allowed to be worn outside – including to and from Mass.

Girls

The items required to be purchased from Lands' End are:

- plaid kilt or plaid skort
- white button down blouse with school logo
- OPTIONAL v-neck sweater, cardigan or sweater vest with school logo

The other dress uniform items that can be purchased through any store are:

- close-toed dress shoes, such as ballet flats, Mary Jane's, saddle oxfords or similar shoes
- Navy knee socks or navy tights

Coats and jackets are allowed to be worn outside - including to and from Mass.

How to order from Lands' End

1. Visit Landsend.com, and select "school" from the horizontal menu at the top of the page.
2. Click "Shop by School."
3. Enter 900152844 in the search bar.
4. Select girl/woman or boy/man. You can click "save school" to set up an account or "skip for now."
5. The easiest next step is to select "show checklist," which you will find at the bottom right corner of the welcome message in the blue rectangle. From there, you can work through the list to select the items that must be from Lands' End (listed above).
